## PREPARATION PRIOR TO TREATMENT

Once our report is approved, our Client Services department will call to schedule a day and time from the treatment.

1. If there is mould on walls behind furniture, please move to provide 1 metre access to the infested area.
2. Occupants are required to vacate the dwelling for the period of the mould treatment plus an additional 2 hours to complete the decontamination fogging.
3. Pets need to be out of the house for this period.

## MOULD REMEDIATION PROCEDURE

**Part A** Remove the visible mould infestation and sanitise the infested areas.

**Part B** Fog the entire dwelling to eliminate the invisible airborne mould spores.

## WHAT IS FOGGING?

Fogging, is the process undertaken to eliminate the invisible air born mould spores. The product is applied by use of a misting device and so can gain far greater and more consistent coverage of an entire home; similar to the steam created when you have a hot shower.

## WHY FOG THE ENTIRE HOUSE?

This is simply because mould spores spread. They are carried on your clothing as well as being present in the air. If the entire dwelling is not fogged, then the mould will return in other rooms under the right conditions. The fogging product is non-hazardous and there will no reaction to the occupants furniture, clothing, food or pets.
